HISTORY:

THE ARKADI M RYWLIN (AMR) INTERNATIONAL PATHOLOGY SLIDE SEMINAR SYMPOSIUM IN ANATOMIC PATHOLOGY IS A SERIES OF INTERNATIONAL MEETINGS SPONSORED AND ORGANIZED BY THE ARKADI M. RYWLIN INTERNATIONAL PATHOLOGY SLIDE CLUB, AN ORGANIZATION DEVOTED TO THE EXCHANGE OF INTERESTING AND CHALLENGING CASES AND TO THE EXCHANGE OF IDEAS AMONG ITS MEMBERS COMPOSED OF A VOLUNTARY GROUP OF ACADEMIC PATHOLOGISTS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. THE FIRST MEETING WAS HELD IN SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO, ITALY, IN 2002. THESE MEETINGS HAVE BEEN HELD AT VARIOUS COUNTRIES THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, INCLUDING THE CZECH REPUBLIC, MEXICO, JAPAN, SWEDEN, TURKEY, ISRAEL, SLOVAKIA, POLAND, AND PORTUGAL. FOR THE 12TH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM, WE HAVE DECIDED TO RETURN TO ITALY WHERE IT ALL STARTED. THE MEETINGS ARE BASED ON SHORT PRESENTATIONS BY THE CLUB MEMBERS OF INTERESTING AND CHALLENGING CASES WHICH ALLOW US TO EXPLORE NEW TOPICS ON CONTROVERSIAL AREAS IN PATHOLOGY IN DETAIL. IN ADDITION TO THE CASE PRESENTATIONS AND THE PLENARY LECTURES BY EXPERTS ON TIMELY TOPICS, THERE WILL BE A COMPETITION AND PRIZES FOR THE ATTENDEES WHO GET THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF CORRECT DIAGNOSES FROM THE WHOLE SLIDE SCANS THAT WILL BE POSTED ONLINE PRIOR TO THE MEETING. PRIZES WILL BE HANDED OUT TO THE FIRST WINNERS IN TWO CATEGORIES: PATHOLOGY RESIDENTS, AND FULL PATHOLOGISTS. WE HOPE THAT YOU WILL JOIN US FOR THIS EXCITING EDUCATIONAL EVENT IN BEAUTIFUL VENICE.

ARKADI M. RYWLIN, M.D.



The *Arkadi M. Rywlin Pathology Slide Seminar* was founded by Dr. Saul Suster in 1991 to honor the memory of his mentor and teacher, the late Professor Arkadi M. Rywlin (1923– 1987).

Professor Rywlin was born in the free city of Danzig and completed his medical training at the University of Geneva, Switzerland. He immigrated to the United States in 1953 and served as the Director of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine at the Mount Sinai Medical Center of Greater Miami and as Professor of Pathology at the University of Miami School of Medicine until his untimely death in 1987. Professor Rywlin attained international recognition for his expertise and numerous publications in the pathology of the bone marrow. He was the

author of more than 100 original articles spanning a variety of subjects in pathology and achieved international recognition with the publication of his textbook on *Histopathology of the Bone Marrow* (Little, Brown & Co., Philadelphia, 1974). Professor Rywlin was an outstanding educator and trained hundreds of residents and fellows. He combined a classical education in pathology with a strictly logical and critical approach to solving problems in pathology. The club was founded to honor the memory of this master of Pathology and to celebrate and promote the spirit of critical thinking that was the legacy of Professor Rywlin to his students.
